

Component Types

Component Type	Code	Description
Abroad Trip	AB	used for CUAbroad placeholder courses (X--- 500) or for trip only "courses" (typically 0 credit standalone courses which can only be taken concurrently with a for-credit abroad course)
Clinical	CLN	instruction occurring outside of the education institution; students provide or contribute to professional services delivered to clients/patients while being supervised by faculty
Colloquia	COL	a seminar-style course typically led by a different lecturer and on a different topic at each meeting
Comprehensive Exam	CE	comprehensive examination (used only for 498, 698, 998)
Continuance	CON	law school only; used for transient student "placeholder" courses
Directed Reading	DR	individualized and self-paced plan of study focused on a set of readings chosen by the professor
Directed Study/ Research	DS	individualized and self-paced plan of study focused on a topic chosen by the professor
Discussion	DIS	primarily small group discussion; generally non-credit bearing component tied to a lecture course
Dissertation Research	DG	dissertation research (used only for 996)
Field Studies	FLD	academic/investigative study outside of the classroom relating to occupational objectives; instructor will develop plan of study in conjunction with the student and provide oversight of work completed
High School Camp	HSC	used for summer camp programs offered to high school students
Independent Study	IND	individualized and self-paced plan of study focused on a topic chosen by the student in consultation with the professor
Internship	INT	on-the-job training/instruction occurring outside of the education institution; instructor will develop details of plan of study in conjunction with the student and provide oversight of work completed
Laboratory	LAB	meets in a defined physical setting for purpose of application of methods
Lecture	LEC	instruction in a traditional classroom setting; may include a variety of pedagogies but is primarily lecture-oriented
Online	ONL	course is taught fully online with no synchronous instruction
Practicum	PRA	supervised practical application of theory; primarily for preparation of clinicians and teachers
Private Instruction	PRV	private instruction courses offered by School of Music (subject code MUPI)
Recital	REC	performance of a program of music or dance
Screening	SCR	media screening of material complementary to course material; generally non-credit bearing component tied to a lecture or seminar course
Seminar	SEM	more interactive and typically smaller than a lecture; lecture is not dominant pedagogy -- course may include presentations, discussion, research
Studio	STD	classwork resulting in a physical product is completed in an on-campus workshop or arts space
Thesis Research	THE	master's/licentiate thesis research (used only for 696)
Tutorial	TUT	instruction given to an individual or very small group on a topic which would otherwise be taught in a lecture-style setting
Workshop	WKS	intensive program focused on techniques and skills of a particular field; course is generally short in nature and is open only to non-degree/certificate seeking students in careers NOCR or CRNA
